We were fortunate to be awarded a couple of sizeable projects that will be kicking into high gear this year, and are looking forward to digging in and delivering the completed systems. Joel Fisher was instrumental in landing multiple projects at a new six story municipal building in Kalamazoo, providing the emergency radio responder, closed circuit television, and access control systems. A fun part of this project was when a vendor raised the price for one of the line items by 53% before we ordered the parts. Luckily having a long-term relationship with them helped, and we were able to get the order placed without suffering too much damage!

In early January Steve Brooks was instrumental in our being awarded a project at the Ultium battery manufacturing plant in Lansing. We will be providing the emergency radio responder, fire alarm and very early warning smoke detection systems. This is a 2.8 million square foot facility, and represents a \$2.8 billion dollar investment to build and equip the factory to produce lithium-ion batteries for GM's electric vehicle line. This is the type of challenging project we love, and we are excited to be on the team!


